In order to **apply** for TPS, you will need to prove three things:

- (1) that you are Haitian,
- (2) that you were residing in the U.S. on January 12, 2011, and (3) that you have been residing in the U.S. continuously since that date.

To **re-register** for TPS (if you already have it), you will need:

- (1) your TPS approval notice
- (2) your Employment Authorization Card

If you were ever arrested, we will need to review all of your Certificates of Disposition to see if you are eligible for TPS.
